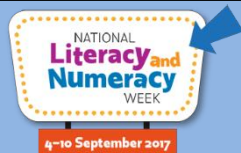

Religious Education

Under the Education Act 2004, Section 29 (1), if the parents of children at a government school ask the Principal for their children to receive religious education in a particular religion, the Principal must ensure that reasonable time is allowed for their children's education in that religion.

As such a request has been received at our school for Christian Education, The Combined Gungahlin Churches will deliver a Christian education session (no more than forty minutes –as per the Education Act) on Wednesday 6 September .
