School Banking

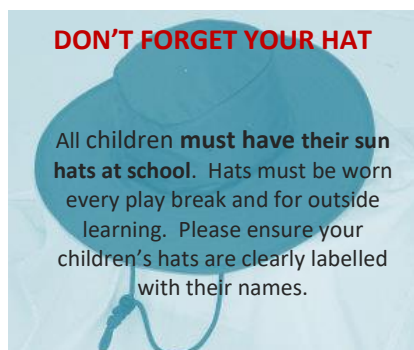
School banking for 2019 is up and running! Drop your bank books off on Tuesday mornings! if you'd to know more, there are information packs available in the front office.

Religious Education

Under the Education Act 2004, Section 29 (1), if the parents of children at a government school ask the Principal for their children to receive religious education in a particular religion, the Principal must ensure that reasonable time is allowed for their children's education in that religion.

As such a request has been received at our school for Christian Education, The Combined Gungahlin Churches will deliver a Christian education session (no more than forty minutes –as per the Education Act) on 6 December . This is suitable for children in the Kindergarten to Year 6 age range. If you wish your child to participate in this session, please complete a permission form which is available from Reception. For organisational reasons, the permission note must be returned to *Reception no later than 9.15am Tuesday 26 March.*
