2018 AUTUMN JUNIOR WEEKENDER
19th & 20th May 2018



The **Autumn Junior Weekender** is one of the major junior chess tournaments for the year. With long time controls 60mins + 10s, players are expected to record moves, but if your child has never recorded moves before or has never played long time control games of chess, please let us know and we'll provide some instructions for practice prior to the tournament.

- When:** **Saturday 19th & Sunday 20th May 2018.** Saturday registration 9.45am, with round 1 commencing 10am. Sunday round commence at 9.30am. Players may request any number of byes before the commencement of play (so if you have sports you still can play in this tournament). Presentation of awards at approximately 4.30pm on Sunday.
- Where:** Campbell High School Hall, Treloar Crescent, Campbell
- Who:** **Open to all boys and girls born on or after 1 January 1998.**
- Cost:** \$40 per player (\$50 if not a current ACTJCL member)
Third and subsequent children from one family are free.
- Time Limits:** 1 hour per player, per game, plus 10 seconds per move from the start.
- Awards:** Championship Shield, Runner Up & 3rd Place, Primary School Shield, plus rating group prizes & Best unrated player.
- Entries:** to Emma Guo, at emma.guo@actjcl.org.au or phone 0423 284 501 (a/h) by Thursday 17th May, including child's name, date of birth, school, current school year and a contact no. where a parent can be contacted on the weekend. ***Late entries will be accepted if space allows.***
- Lunch:** Bring your own lunch, or pizza and drink is available for \$7 per child per day. Snacks and drinks can be purchased throughout the weekend. **Please note that we have a nut free environment.**

Notes: Parents are asked to provide details to the organiser of any medical or custodial issues for your child. This should include any known allergies, chronic medical conditions and behavioural issues that may have an impact on your child's participation in, and enjoyment of, our activities. Please make us aware of any medication that your child carries – we will require them to self-administer any medication. If in doubt, please stay and enjoy the weekend with your child.
